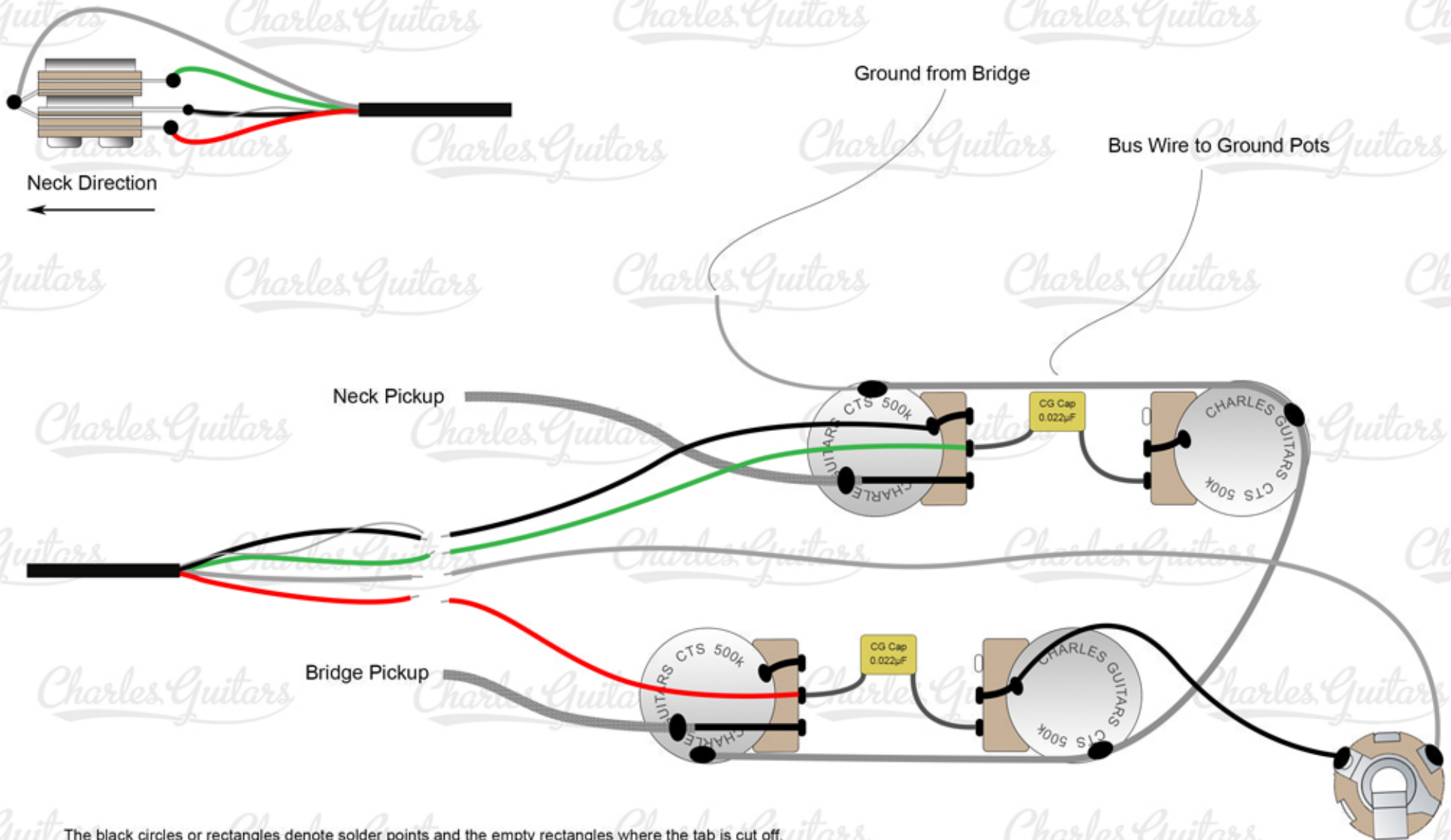


Gibson originally used braided wire for the switch but changed to 4 conductor wire, tonally this does not make a difference as it is only a switching circuit. Gibson also mounted the controls on a metal plate with a terminal block. You can trace the wires using this diagram and retain the terminal block or discard the metal plate in which case you should shield the control cavity with shield paint (CH50004). Gibson also uses predominantly pickups with braided wire as below however if you are using 4 conductor wire pickups please refer to your manufactureres instructios regarding the wiring.



The black circles or rectangles denote solder points and the empty rectangles where the tab is cut off.
